#### **PREFACE**

The material included in these pages is meant to give you, the rollista, something as a basic help in your presentation of the ACTION talk. You are encouraged to follow the outline guide for DIRECTION OF CONTENT, but NOT AS THE CONTENT itself.

The ACTION talk comes at the middle point of the series of talks for the. weekend. It centers on personal contact; the heart of the work is drawing people towards Christ. This talk should be clear and explanatory; should explain the place of ACTION

in the Christian life. As you prepare your talk, please be sure to read all the supporting

Scripture passages, then choose those passages which seem most appropriate for your rollo. When you give your rollo~ please read the passages you choose as a part of your talk. Let God speak through His Word and tell how it relates to you and your experiences in life. This is a witness talk, so make it personal. Make it YOU—it's your talk. The amount of time allotted is a maximum of 30 minutes.

There are a few additional materials included that might be helpful to you. All material given to you is meant to guide your thinking while at the same time you have the freedom of your individual expression. God's Blessings be yours as you prepare for your presentation of the ACTION rollo.

- 1. Action by God's people, which is based upon the disciples/apostles as role models, and, which is used to bring God's Good News–Jesus Christ–to the world.

### John 1:40-49, Matt. 28:19

- 2. Action that comes from motivations that are elevated and empowered by God's grace, that is filled with His love, and, that is used for the spreading of His Kingdom.
- 3. Action directed by Study, founded on and moved by Piety; Piety and study nourish us to feed our lives in

Grace in order that the end result may be Action. To be unfailing and fruitful, action must always be guided by piety and study; all are needed for Life in Grace.

4. Action that is most effective as a lifestyle–a way of life–a natural sharing of the good news of Jesus Christ in our lives.

Jesus Christ is Love in Action. I John 3:16-18, I John 4: 1 9

Love characterizes His Word and His Lifestyle. He is the complete revelation of God's Love. When through His grace we reflect that love in our actions to others so that they want to know who Jesus is, we are sharing the Gospel. As God's people, we become Good News people in action. <u>Luke 11:28</u>, <u>Gen. 12:1</u>,2, <u>Matt. 9:35-38</u>

Don't only act like a Christian; be a Christian.

All that I say and do, reflects whether or not Jesus is living in me.
